Wow, what a finish to a great year!! And, we could not have asked for or received better weather! And the golf was fabulous (wish I was there... oh wait, I was—just forgot my “A” game). Actually, the Two-Day is all about zigging when your partner zags and vice versa. Martin and I didn’t do that. I’ll explain later...

Let’s start by singling them out...

Don’t really know where to begin, so let’s just start with the day money. On Saturday **Bill Erickson** set the pace with a **net 68**. That of course clearly put him in the lead for the two day individual.

people tied for 5th at **net 73: Tony Bennis, Bob Lamping, Ron Martin** and **yours truly**.

As for the teams, 1st on Saturday was **Tony Bennis** and **Bob Lamping** at **net -9** (not bad for each posting individual net 73’s!). **Rocco**

Consalvo and **Gary Riseling** also posted a team **net -9**. In third place at **net -8** were three teams: **Phil Singler/Gary Riseling; Mike Prus/Terry Freeman; and Steve Miller/Ken Mahoney**. Three teams came in just behind at **net -7**, so this became a tight team race for the final stretch on Sunday with 8 teams within 2 strokes of each other.

Now back to that zig-zag thing I was talking about. The individual scores for the teams that tied for 1st place had net 73/73 and net 70/76. Third place 76/77 for -8...very good. The same went for Prus/Freeman. However, Martin and I were a 73/73 and we only were at net -4; and Erickson and Tisinai were a 68/79 for only a -5.

Team Sunday

So the stage was set for Sunday, and now it was time to see who would make their move. It didn't take long; the teams were coming in with some fine numbers. The second group had **Kelly Rafferty/Greg Mulac** coming in at **net -10**. By the way--Rafferty chipped in on holes 7, 8, and 10. I do not recall seeing three chip-ins over 18 holes (let alone 3 times in four holes!) by one person. *Geeeee*, he had only two putts in that string of four holes. As for the individual scores, **Bill Erickson**, playing in the third group, came in with another **net 68**

for a two day total of **net 136**. That left everyone shooting at Erickson's net 68/136 for 1st place Individual day money and Two-Day Individual Low Total.

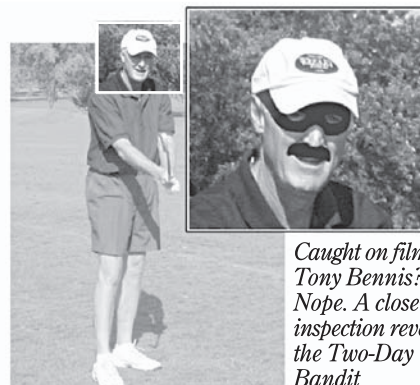
Bobby Gus came close with a net 69. **Greg Mulac** had also had a net 69 and Bob Lamping had a net 70. But those scores did not hold up when the final

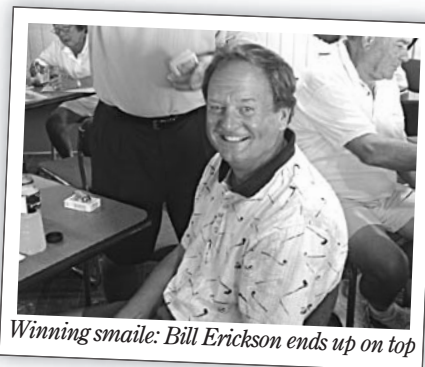
The Two-Day totals take shape

Bartlett Boys, **Ron Martin** (73/71) and **Greg Mulac** (75/69).

I also think it was very interesting to watch the leaderboard over the two days. Bill Erickson was in first on Saturday, and he finished first. Rocco and George Lamping were tied for second, but dropped to fourth. Miller was fourth and moved up to second; Bob Lamping was tied for fifth but moved up to a tie for fourth. 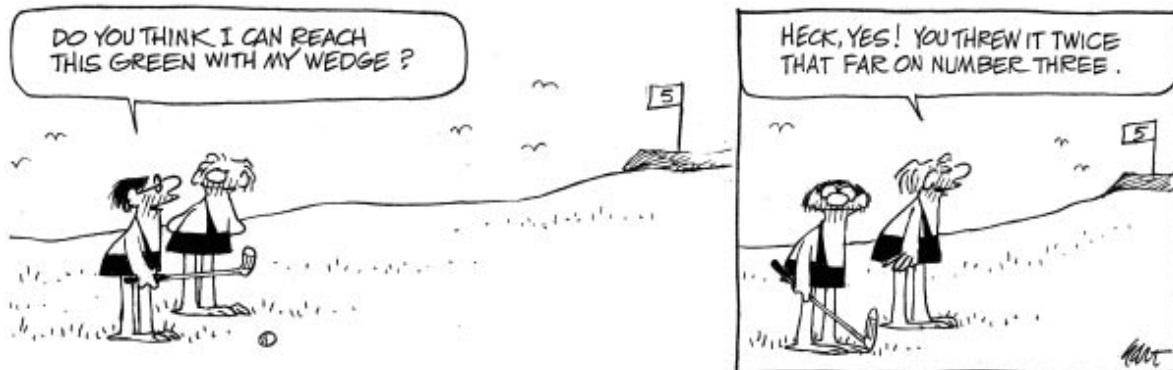
